- For signing/changing the Learning Agreement, you need to contact your Erasmus Coordinator (you can find the list of Erasmus coordinators in your welcome kit, or online at this link)





# **University emails & credentials**

- In order to obtain your UKE institutional email, Wi-Fi credentials and student ID number ("matricola"), you need to complete the registration procedure at the KIRO office.
- UKE institutional email will be necessary to access the University IT tools, e.g. the platform for booking and registering exams: *Esse3* and the online teaching platform <u>Unikorefad</u>.
- KIRO staff will supervise enrollment procedures.







# Tax Code (Codice Fiscale)

- The Fiscal Code (Codice Fiscale) is a code made up of letters and numbers and it is used by the Public Administration to identify the citizens living in Italy. All those living in Italy need to have their own.
- It is possible to obtain it at the local Revenue Agency (Uffici Locali dell'Agenzia delle Entrate), bringing along the form filled in, the passport / Identity Card and a photocopy of it. More info here.







#### **ERSU CARD**



International/Erasmus students can request the ERSU card to Ersu Office. The card provides discounts for services, such as urban buses and the canteen.

- Exams in Italy are held in multiple sessions.
- The **winter session** (January -February) is only available for courses taught in the first semester. The **summer session** (June-July) is available for courses taught in the I, II or both semesters.
- Each session offers two exam dates ("appelli") for every subject.
- If you didn't pass an exam during the first *appello*, you can take the exam again on the following date, <u>even if it is in the same session</u>.
- Exam dates are published on the Web Agenda.





# Language of instruction

- All classes are taught in Italian (except some from the foreign language department). Erasmus students may contact professors to inquire about their availability to provide reading materials in other languages.
- All exams are held in Italian, and many exams may be oral. Erasmus students may contact professors to inquire about their availability to run the exam in a foreign language.

# **Gym: E-CO KORE wellness**


The gym is situated at Engineering and Architecture building (ground floor)
